

## The IRF Greenhouse Gas Calculator features at the IHT Symposium

The Nottingham symposium organised yearly by the Institution of Highways and Transportation took place on the 24<sup>th</sup> January at the Village Hotel and Leisure Club of Nottingham.

Practitioners, researchers, engineers gathered this year to address the topic of climate change by identifying the challenges that it poses to the road sector and by presenting techniques in use to mitigate its risks and to reduce emissions.

Susanna Zammataro - Environment Project Manager of IRF Geneva Programme Centre - delivered a presentation on Roads and the Environment and on the IRF Greenhouse Gas Calculator. Alternative materials, bio-fuels, bio-binders and green pavement design were also among the topics addressed.

The symposium revealed the growing interest and concern about greenhouse gas emissions monitoring and accounting thus confirming the opportunity of IRF Greenhouse Gas Calculator for the road sector.
